

Supplementary Information About the M+ Collection Archives

The M+ Collection Archives is a repository of valuable primary documents that lends deeper insights into the creative processes of artists and makers within the M+ Collections, which also comprise the M+ Collection, M+ Sigg Collection, and M+ Library Special Collection. Since its founding, M+ has acquired archives in parallel with objects, placing equal importance on both. The museum's archival holdings are particularly rich in material from the period of the 1960s to the 1990s and include a wide range of items such as artist sketches, design drawings, photographs, and printed and digitised ephemera by artists, architects, and graphic designers from around the world.

A majority of the M+ Collection Archives consists of fonds for design and architecture. M+ began acquiring archival materials related to these disciplines in 2013 as part of its interest in historicising design and architectural production in Hong Kong and across Asia for display, research, and conservation. The materials related to design and architecture in the M+ Collection Archives have been acquired based on the curatorial team's research focus on figures, narratives, and transnational network of ideas, resulting from a degree of serendipity. These include documenting the works of pioneering architectural and design practices in Hong Kong (1950s–1990s) and mainland China (1990s–2010s), the practice of diaspora Chinese architects in Taiwan (1950s–1990s), post-colonial national building and tropical regionalism in Southeast Asia (1950s–1980s), proponents of experimental architectural and urban design practices (1940s–2000s), and projects that expand the conceptual framework of postmodernism in Asia (1970s–1990s).

An immense number of resources are required to catalogue the fonds that M+ has acquired. Preserving and cataloguing the archives continues to be an ongoing process. We hope to provide access in the near future to many sizeable fonds related to the works of designers and architects such as Archigram, Alan Chan, Henry Steiner, and Palmer & Turner.

There are currently forty-three fonds related to design and architecture that have been processed. The catalogues listed are available online and can be accessed onsite at the M+ Research Centre:
